Material Description

MasterCast 281 is an innovative admixture specially developed for earth-dry concretes. The product is particularly suitable for the production of concrete bricks & blocks. MasterCast 281 reduces the cycle time whilst the appearance is maintained or even improved. MasterCast 281 is a key component our FIT 4 VALUE concept.

- Block paving mixes.
- Concrete bricks.

- Optimised mix design.

- Enhanced productivity due to shorter cycle time.

Application Procedure

MasterCast 28 I is a liquid ready-to-use admixture to be added to the concrete during the mixing process. The best results are obtained when the admixture is added after all the other components are already in the mixer and after the addition of at least 80% of the total water. The water content is adjusted to obtain the desired consistence or workability.

Dosage

The normally recommended dosage rate for MasterCast 281 is 0.2 to 1.0 litres per 100 kg of cement.

The dosage rates given above are for typical usages, they are not meant as absolute limits, as other dosages may be utilised in special cases according to specific job conditions. If required consult our Technical Services Department for advice. Trial mixes should be carried out to ensure optimum dosage and effect.

Compatability

MasterCast 281 can be used with most types of EN 197 Cements. For use with Pulverised Fuel Ash, or any other special cements, contact our Technical Services Department.

MasterCast 281 should not be pre-mixed with other admixtures. If other admixtures are to be used in concrete containing MasterCast 281 they must be dispensed separately.

MasterCast 281 is compatible with other MBCC admixtures such as accelerators and water repellents.

When such complimentary admixtures are required it is important that laboratory trials are performed, prior to any supply, to determine the respective dosages of any complimentary admixture, and the suitability, in the fresh and hardened state, of the resultant mortar or concrete. In these circumstances we recommend that you consult our Technical Services Department for further advice.

Packaging

MasterCast 281 is supplied in 1000-litre IBC's and 15-litre containers.
